

Tools & Supplies: 12" Decorative Trimmer, 12" Trimmer, 2 Base Papers, 2 Double-Sided Prints, I Sheet of Coordinating Paper, Embellishments

Most of the cut guide is photo mats, but you do want to cut four $I^* \times IO^*$ strips of paper. I recommend cutting mats to size as desired for your photos.

To hack the base papers, choose two base papers and two doublesided printed papers



- I. Cut one of the printed papers down to 10° x 12° , then cut in half at 5° with the 12° Decorative Trimmer (your choice of swell or wavy) to create two 5° x 12° pieces.
- 2. From the other double-sided print, cut down to 10° x 12° , then cut in half to create two 6° x 10° rectangles.
- 3. Adhere the 10" x 6" rectangle 1" down from the top of the base paper, centered 1" from each edge. Layer and adhere the swell/wavy piece 1" from the bottom of the base paper.
- 4. Adhere the I" x 10" strips at the top and bottom of each page as shown.

***I pulled up the swell piece higher on the right page so I could fit four photos below it. I added the $2" \times 12"$ strip cut in Step 2 to fill the space. I used ABC Monograms for the title, and added a strip along the top seam as accent.
