



Christmas Charm Tree Layout Creative Memories Blog – 11/19/24



Tools & Supplies:

Bright White Cardstock, Christmas Charm Paper, 12" Trimmer, Pencil



Step 1: Cut a piece of yellow stripes paper to measure 12" x 8".

Adhere to the top portion of the Bright White Cardstock base.

Step 2: Create the left tree using three coordinating 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" prints. Avocado mat is 3-3/4" x 5-3/4" (midpoint is 1-7/8").

- On one end of each piece, mark with a pencil at 1-3/4". Cut from the outside corners to the pencil mark to create the triangle. Choose one for the base and set to the side.
- Choose one for the middle layer. Cut off 1/2" from one side of the triangle. Adhere to the base triangle.
- From the 3rd mat, cut off 1" from one side of the triangle. Adhere to the previous triangle piece.

Step 3: Create the center tree using three coordinating 4" x 6" prints. Use the same process as Step 2 but mark the center of each piece at 2". Avocado mat is 4-1/4" x 6-1/4" (midpoint is 2-1/8").

Step 4: Create the right tree using three coordinating 3" x 5" prints. Use the same process as Step 2 but mark the center of each piece at 1-1/2". Avocado mat is 3-1/4" x 5-1/4" (midpoint is 1-5/8").

Step 5: Adhere all three trees to the layout along the bottom left side of the yellow stripes paper, placing one of the trees using Foam Squares or Foam Tape if desired.

Step 6: Adhere border stickers along the top edge and along the bottom edge of the trees/yellow stripes paper. Adhere the remaining stickers, along with Write On Sticker Strips for journaling.

Photo Mats as shown from Avocado Cardstock: (3) 3-3/4" squares for 3-1/2" photos and (1) 4-1/4" square for a 4" photo.
